




We have run out of tissues, so if anyone is going shopping we would be very grateful for tissue donations.

Please can all parents take care when crossing the local road with their children, and to use the crossing with their children. This will help all the children to learn road safety skills that could save a life. We received a call from a local resident who was very shaken by a near miss on the road. This was a Nursery or F2 parent who had a pushchair and toddler but was crossing the road to the Coop without really being aware of cars having to stop suddenly to avoid hitting her and the children. We are really concerned that one day there will be a fatal accident on this bend in the road and it would be terrible were it to be one of our pupils who was killed. Please if you are not already doing so, consider taking a little more time to walk up to the crossing and use this. It will help your child's safety in the long run. In addition, please can all parents ensure that their child does not cross the byway in front of the school on their own as this is still technically a road and cars drive up and down it at times. We cannot legally stop this although we ask that parents do not drive down there at the beginning and end of each day for safety's sake. Thank you for your support.
