<p>Maths</p>	<p>Can you make some Rainbow Fairy cakes together? See if you can weigh and measure the ingredients together.</p> <p>Recipe: Preheat oven to 200 C / Gas mark 6.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Cream the sugar and butter until pale and fluffy.</li> <li>2. Beat the eggs in one at a time, adding a little flour in each time, until the ingredients are mixed.</li> <li>3. Add the vanilla essence and mix. Then add the milk 1 tbsp at a time, mixing after each addition.</li> <li>4. Divide the mixture into 6 bowls: In Bowl 1 - Add half a cap of red colouring In Bowl 2 - Add half a cap of red and half a cap of yellow In Bowl 3 - Add half a cap of yellow In Bowl 4 - Add half a cap of green In Bowl 5 - Add half a cap of blue In Bowl 6 - Add half a cap of blue and half a cap of red Mix colouring into each mixture after adding.</li> <li>5. Divide the purple mixture between the 12 cases. Repeat with the other mixtures in this order: Blue, Green, Yellow, Orange, Red.</li> <li>6. Bake in the preheated oven for 10-15 minutes.</li> </ol>
<p>Understanding The World</p>	<p>When you are baking, can you talk about what is happening to the ingredients. How does the mixture change? What happens when the mixture goes in the oven.</p>
