This term we are excited to explore, discover, understand and celebrate light and dark;

Communication and Language

Learning and using new vocabulary and story language throughout the school day, from stories we read together this term. These stories include; Rama and Sita, Owl Babies, Peace at Last and non-fiction texts including light sources and nocturnal animals. We will be trying to re-tell a story, listening carefully at carpet time to develop text familiarity.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Together we will be celebrating differences between us, focusing on including others in our play, solving problems, using kind words and practicing giving and receiving compliments.

Physical

Bollywood dancing comes to Shinfield this term! We are looking forward to practicing our dance moves in our PE lessons, alongside throwing and catching and invasion games with a rugby focus.

Literacy

Continuing to practise our pre-cursive writing, focusing on character writing using our key text this term. Writing letters to Needles the Hedgehog, with safety advice throughout bonfire night.

Maths

We will be representing numbers to 5, Focussing on the fluency of number and finding one more and one less. We will also be looking at shapes with 4 sides.

Understanding the World

Thinking about then and now, we will be discussing The Gunpowder Plot and the importance of Remembrance in our community. We will also be looking at our local village area and the buildings around us and asking questions such as 'What happens at the Post office?' We will also be taking a walk to the post office to post letters and cards.

Expressive Arts and Design

Using our creative skills this term we will be investigating and making an Autumn sun catcher, making Poppies for a whole school display, designing our own Christmas cards and crafts. In dance we will also be exploring Bollywood dancing and moving our bodies in time to music and of course, our festive show, One Starry Night.
