1. Counting objects around the home or when out and about is a brilliant and easy way to practice this term's KIRF. This can be done with anything! Such as Lego pieces, road signs, cars, birds, leaves, rocks. Count objects into piles, count forwards and then see if you can count backwards!
2. Singing number songs is a fun way to practice your numbers! There are lots of counting songs where the numbers are going forwards and backwards, such as '10 Green Bottles'.
