Summer I in Year 2

This term we our topic is "BIRDS, ANIMALS AND HABITATS".

Writing

This term we will be writing non-chronological reports on Barn Owls The children will also be learning how to write an adventure story based on the book "The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark." We will be writing letters based on "The Day the Crayons Quit". We continue to focus on spelling of our common exception words and these are attached for you to practise at home.

Maths

We are excited to begin this term by exploring fractions. We will be learning how to recognise and find halves, quarters, three-quarters and thirds of shapes and numbers. Towards half term we move onto time: understanding years, months, weeks, days, hours, minutes and seconds. We will be learning how to tell the time to o'clock, half past and quarter past/quarter to. As our term progresses and we approach our end of Key Stage 1 assessments, we will be revisiting past units of work and supporting the children with the things they find particularly tricky. At home, it would be helpful to revise numbers bonds to and within 10 and use these to reason and calculate bonds to 20. Please continue to work on this term's KIRFS

Science

We will be learning all about birds, their habitats, their main body parts, key facts about their features and how they reproduce. We will be exploring how animals obtain their food from plants and looking at food chains. We will also work together to understanding different animal habitats and how they provide the basic needs of different types of animals.

PE

In Basketball this term, we will be honing our ball game skills with bounce passing and chasing a ball during game play. We will be focusing on reacting quickly to catch a dropped ball, how to intercept a pass and how to block a shot, standing 1m away.

History

It's all about chronology this term! We will be understanding how to create a time line and how our small school became a big school! We will find out when different parts of the school were built by looking at the building and in scrapbook evidence. We will be inviting in former pupils and comparing how the school uniform, building and rules have changed over time.

Art and DT

Our artist of the term is Henry Moore. We will be critically evaluating his sculpture work and making our own clay owls. In DT we will be learning how to make moveable minibeasts using the lever and pivot mechanism.

Computing

This term we will be focusing on what it takes to write a code for a programme and explaining how we achieved such.

RE

In Religious Education this term we will be learning to understand why Muslims visit the mosque and to explore whether this gives them a sense of belonging.

PSHE

We will be learning about relationships, thinking about trust and appreciation, friendships and conflict.

Music

We will be learning to sing and compose our songs for our end of year performance, Pirates vs.
