

Summer 1 in Nursery

Communication and Language

Children will be working on building more complex sentences to talk to peers and adults. They will use talk as a means to express emotions. They will start to take account of others ideas and opinions. They will use past and present tenses.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Children will begin to solve conflicts by using words. They will use the sand timer to take turns with minimal adult support. They will be able to listen to others ideas and opinions.

Physical

Children will participate in daily fine motor activities and will be able to form most letters in their names.

Children will be able to put their own shoes on and off.

Literacy

Children will be able to hear and say the syllables and initial sounds in words.

They will be able to link some letters to sounds.

Maths

Children will be able to identify a circle, square, rectangle and triangle. They will be able to talk about the number of sides and vertices. They will know the difference between flat/solid shapes and name a cube and sphere.

They will be able to use 1:1 correspondence to count to ten and recognise numerals 1 to 5.

Understanding the World

Children will be able to observe the lifecycle of a frog and butterfly and talk about the changes they can see.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will develop their expressive skills by singing, dancing, role play. Exploring music and different resources and materials.
