

## Spring 1 in Nursery

### Communication and Language

Children will be developing their language skills, by using clear speech which can be understood by others. They will start to use pronouns correctly in speech, and be able to express an opinion.

### Personal, Social and Emotional

Children will develop their sense of self, they will begin to understand how their actions can affect another person. They will be able to name simple emotions and talk about what makes them happy or sad. They will show good listening skills when sitting on the carpet.

### Physical

Children will be able to put their own shoes on and off. They will begin to trace the letters in their names. Daily fine motor activities to develop correct grip.

### Literacy

We will be learning a letter a week following the “Little Wandle” scheme that runs throughout school. We will look at rhyming words and start to identify initial sounds in words.

### Maths

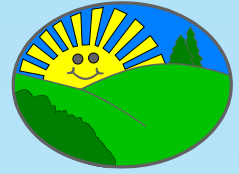
Count in sequence to ten  
Subitise to 3  
Count out 10  
Count out an irregular group of 5  
Repeat an ABA pattern  
Match quantity to numeral 1 - 5

### Understanding the World

Children will be able to note the changes occurring around them, notice changing weather. Know that they were once babies and are growing. Looking at their immediate environment—My family—My Nursery—My school

### Expressive Arts and Design

Children will develop their expressive skills by singing, dancing, role play. Exploring music and different resources and materials.
